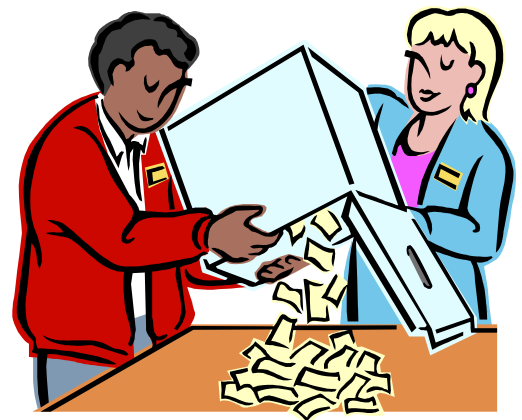

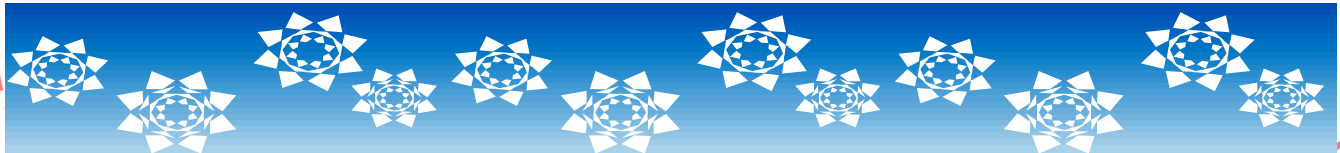
August 26, 2012 minutes reviewed. Lynne Sherry made a motion to approve the August 26, 2012 minutes. Seconded. Approved.

Next board meeting is scheduled for November 11, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.

New Business:

1. Sandy Dukes has volunteered to be 2013 Fall Show Chairperson.
2. Haleys is ordering a new electronic door lock. The door lock that was installed is not working correctly. All other doors to the building have also received new locks. The building owners have keys only to the 2 south doors and the north-east door. New deadbolts have been installed on the east and northwest doors. Instructors, board members, and trial chairs will have keys to these doors.
3. First year dues are \$20/\$25: current renewal dues are \$40 for a single membership and \$50 for a family membership. Junior handlers pay \$20 for new and renewal membership. New members whose second reading is after September 1st shall have dues applied to the following year's membership.
4. Education committee needs to have written guidelines on lead instructor application, evaluation and approval process.
5. AKC has increased from 8 to 12 days for agility trials. Karen Sollars has volunteered to Trial Chair for an agility trial scheduled for October 2013.
