Report on 2013 Memberships Renewals

As of November, 2012 the GLKC membership roles totaled 80 total memberships, including 59 single memberships and 21 family memberships (102 voting members).

As of February 1, 2013 the GLKC membership roles totaled 64 total memberships, including 48 single memberships and 16 family memberships (82 voting members).

Of the memberships not renewed:

- 4 were oversights on the part of the member. They intend to submit an application to reinstate their memberships, and one has already done so.
- 2 members moved away from the area in 2012 and did not renew.
- 2 chose not to renew because of changes in their family and/or dog situation.
- The remainder were not renewed and did not respond to reminder emails.

At the February membership meeting we welcomed 1 new member. We currently have 4 pending membership applications: 3 new memberships and 1 past member reinstating.

President Jim Peterson made the following Announcements:

Feb 1, 2013 is the deadline for membership renewals. Any renewal form and fee post-marked and received after that date will not be accepted. In these cases, the member will have to re-apply and go through the approval format.

Reminder: It is important that a member must turn down thermostat to 58 when he/she is the last one leaving building in order to control heating costs.

The club is looking for educational suggestions for our meetings or for seminars. All suggestions will be welcomed.

GLKC has been approved for the OB/Rally trial the first week of April (4/6 and 4/7). The Premium list is on the GLKC website. Get your entry in early. Workers are also needed.
